Governor Walker Calls Special Election Cheryl Hancock Releases Statement on Budget Repair Bill

Holmen – On Tuesday February 22nd Governor Walker called the special election for the 94th Assembly District with the primary slated for April 5th and the General Election scheduled to be held on May 3rd. On Thursday February 17th Cheryl Hancock announced her candidacy for the 94th Assembly district to fill the seat which has been vacant since Mike Huebsch was appointed Secretary of the Department of Administration.

Statement
